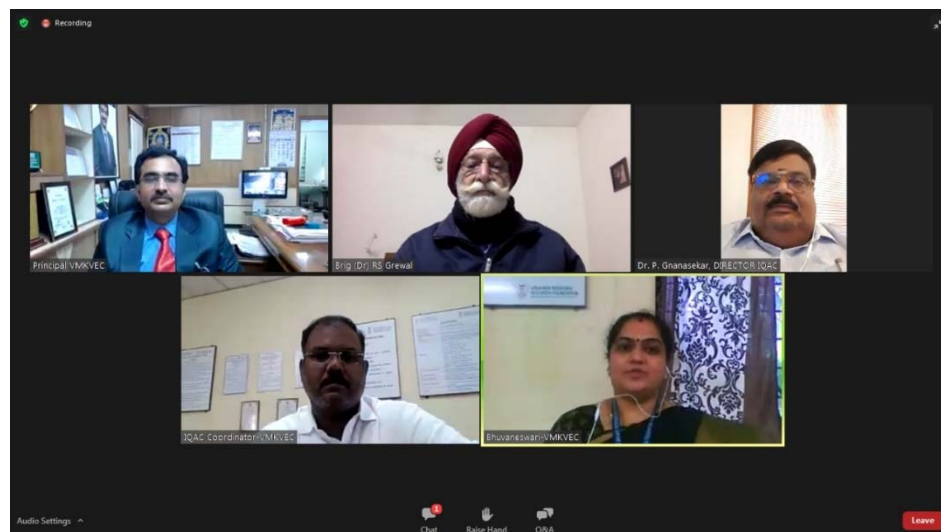

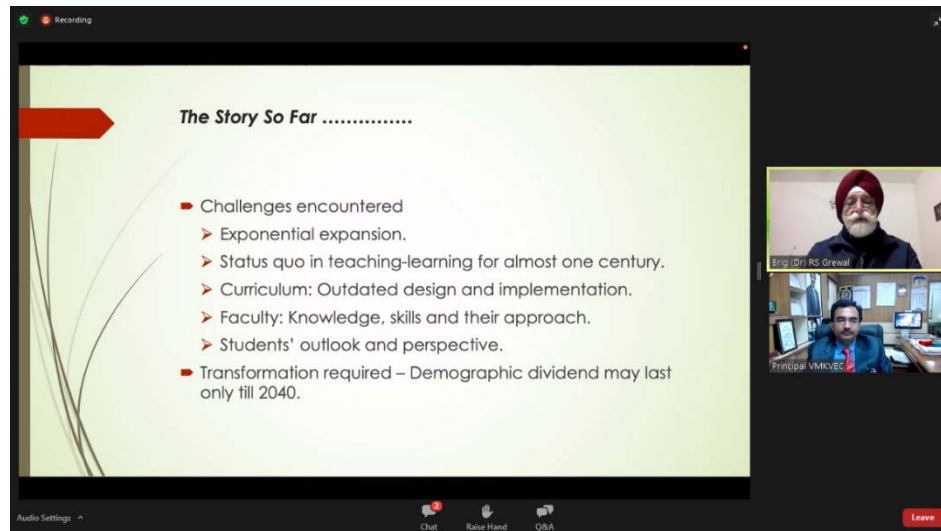
REPORT OF THE WEBINAR

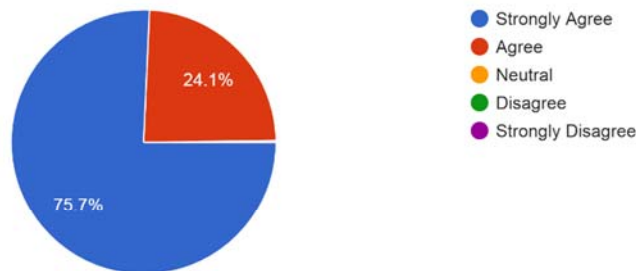

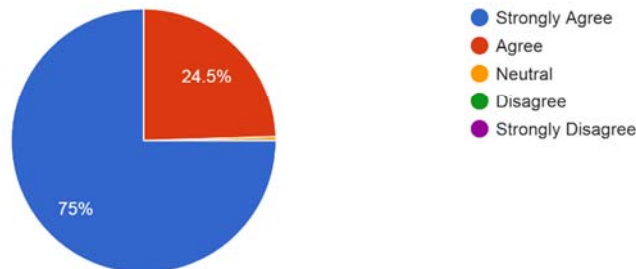

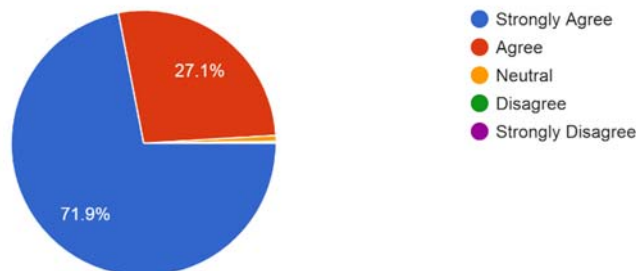

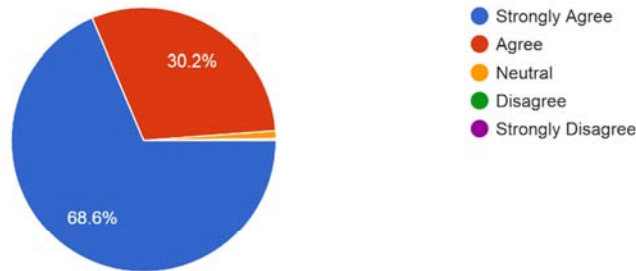

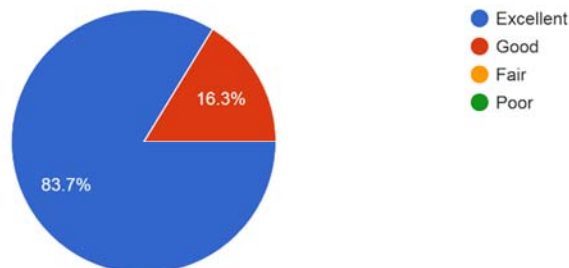

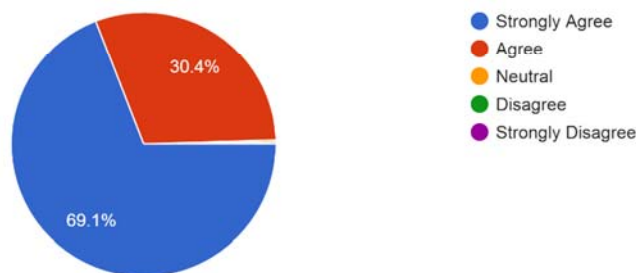
